Baltic Junior Cup, 23–25 October 2020

Bulletin 1

The organizers, Finlands Svenska Orienteringsförbund FSO and OK Raseborg, warmly welcome participants from the Baltic Sea region to the Baltic Junior Cup 2020, which will take place in Ekenäs/Tammisaari, Raseborg/Raasepori, on 23–25 October 2020.

General information

The event centre and hard floor accommodation are located in the town of Ekenäs/Tammisaari in the municipality of Raseborg/Raasepori. Ekenäs is situated approximately 90 kilometers west of the capital Helsinki/Helsingfors and 100 kilometers south east of Turku/Åbo (approximately 1.5 hours by bus and 1.5 hours by train from both directions). The competition arena will be at Grabbskog rally cross track, Tenalavägen 416 (road 52), nearby the lake Grabbskog storräsk. The distance from the event centre and the accommodation to the arena is approximately 8 km (10 minutes by car or bus).

Entries and fees

Entries are made using an online registration form (to be published), one registration per team. Last entry date is 5 October 2020. On the registration form, please fill in the following information:

- Name of the team.
- List runners in order according to class.
- For the runners, within each class, list the runners in order from weakest to strongest in rank (highest ranked last).
- For each runner, please indicate:
 - Class
 - Surname
 - First name
 - Year of birth
 - EMIT number (or need of rental EMIT).
- For GPS tracking in classes W20 and M20, please indicate two runners in W20 and M20 who will wear the tracking unit.
- For team leaders:
 - Surname
 - First name.
- Total participation fee for the team (entry fee: 40 € for each athlete and each team leader).
- Contact information for the team:
 - Name
 - E-mail
 - Phone number.



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If possible, please consider providing some background information on the runners. This would be highly appreciated by the arena speaker.

The organizers will provide a rental EMIT card for entries without EMIT numbers. Fee 4 €/card, 80 €/lost card.

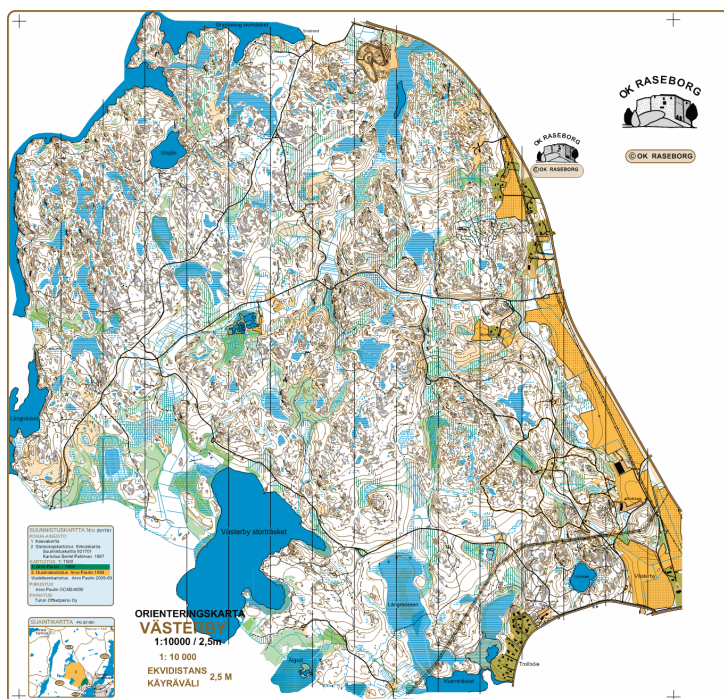
An entry fee of 40 € will be charged for each runner and each team leader. This fee covers competition starts, hard floor accommodation and all meals mentioned in the programme.

Special fees for Finnish regional teams outside the cup competition: long distance 20 €/runner, relay 100 €/mixed relay team including 6 runners. This fee only covers the right to start in the competitions.

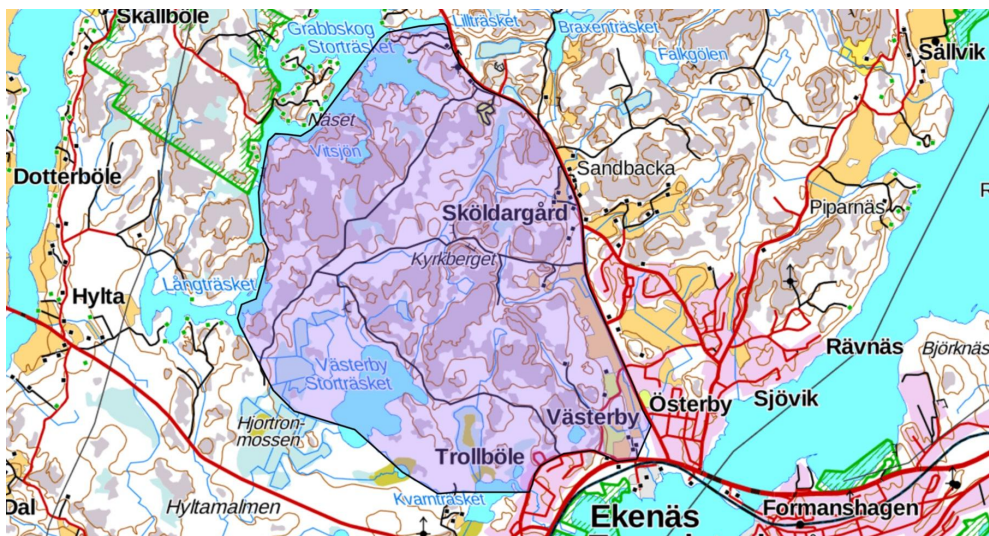


Embargo

Participants and team leaders are not allowed to use the embargoed area (marked below in purple) for training before 25 October 2020.



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Classes

- Long distance: M16, W16, M18, W18, M20, W20
- Mixed relay: 1st leg M18 (1st runner) and W18 (2nd runner); 2nd leg M16 (3rd runner) and W16 (4th runner); 3rd leg W20 (5th runner); 4th leg M20 (6th runner).

Team competition

The overall standings of the teams will be calculated on the basis of the results of each team's three best individual runners of each class in the long distance competition together with the three best mixed relay team results.

Open courses

There will be open courses available. More information in bulletin 2.

Punching system

EMIT will be used. The organizers provide rental EMIT cards (4 €) for entries without EMIT number; 80 €/lost card.

Accommodation

Accommodation on hard floor. Please bring your own sleeping bags and mattresses.
